



Getting to Dean Walters Building

If you are arriving by car, please allow plenty of time to negotiate the ongoing roadworks in the centre of Liverpool. Follow directions for the Anglican Cathedral and the Dean Walters Building is next door. There is parking available below the building, you should turn into Arch View Crescent from Upper Duke Street, there is a barrier with an intercom system, say you are attending the conference.

If you are travelling by public transport the easiest way to get to the Dean Walters Building is by taxi (taxis are plentiful and relatively cheap in Liverpool), ask for the Anglican Cathedral and we are next door.

Alternatively we are 10-15 minutes walk from Lime Street or Central stations

Note that Liverpool has two cathedrals, so you need to specify the Anglican Cathedral (the big red one).

The Dean Walters Building is not particularly well signposted from Upper Duke Street and St James Road is not signposted at all
