

Panel Guidelines and Notes on Accommodation and Travel

Papers should be no more than 20 minutes in length to allow time for questions. Please list any AV requirements on your registration form which will be circulated shortly. The registration fee for students/unwaged is £10 and for staff/waged £25. A draft copy of the conference programme will be available in the next few days, but I attach an outline programme here so that you can get a sense of how the day is structured.

The conference venue, LJMU's Dean Walters Building, is conveniently located next to Liverpool's neo-Gothic Anglican Cathedral, a short walk from both Lime Street and Central Station. Liverpool John Lennon Airport is just 8 miles from the city centre and Manchester Airport (an international gateway to the US and beyond) is 55 minutes drive or 90 minutes by train. Liverpool city centre is only 2 hours and 15 minutes from London Euston via train.

Liverpool has a wide range of hotels to suit all pockets, from the Youth Hostel Association from about £19 per night and the Britannia Adelphi Hotel from about £45 per night to the Crowne Plaza from £110 per night and the Malmaison from £149 per night.

Other hotels include: Jury's Inn from £69 per night; Holiday Inn from £70 per night; Premier Inn (Albert Dock) from £72.50 per night; Novotel from £79; Staybridge Suites from £79 per night; Premier Apartments Liverpool from £79 per night; The Feathers Hotel from £84; Imagine Apartments from £105 per night; Radisson SAS Hotel from £140 per night.

All of the above hotels and hostels are located within 15-20 minutes walking distance of the Dean Walters Building. The Feathers Hotel and the Novotel are the closest hotels to the venue.
