Creative alternatives

Stay on the Wirral (i.e. the area of Merseyside on the other side of the River Mersey) or in Warrington since direct trains run between Manchester and Liverpool which stop at Warrington, so, although you're out of town, you should be able to get there fairly easily – perhaps more so than if you book a room in an outlying part of Merseyside itself.

If you stay in Warrington, look for accommodation close to Warrington Central station, as this has the best train services to and from Liverpool, though trains do also run to and from Warrington Bank Quay station. For timetables go to www.thetrainline.com

If you stay on the Wirral, check for somewhere close to a train station so that you can take the Wirral line into central Liverpool. The Merseytravel site at www.merseytravel.gov.uk gives details of services and has an interactive journey planner, plus a map of the network at http://www.merseytravel.gov.uk/pdf/merseyrail_network_map1.pdf
